HORSE FIRST AID KIT CHECK LIST

While its impossible to be prepared for every eventuality for horses injuring themselves, a well stocked first aid kit is the first step to providing emergency first aid. We recommend having two first aid kits – one at your stables/home and one for travel.

Use the following checklist to check your first aid kit is ready to go:
